

The Nature Conservancy, NJ: Additional Preserves

Skylands Minisink Valley Preserve

MONTAGUE TOWNSHIP, SUSSEX COUNTY, NJ

The preserve is situated within the forested land between the Delaware River and the large areas of land protected by the State of New Jersey, at the very tip of northern New Jersey.

Mashipacong Bogs Preserve

MONTAGUE TOWNSHIP, SUSSEX COUNTY, NJ

1,000-acre Mashipacong Bogs Preserve borders both High Point and Stokes state parks.

Arctic Meadows Preserve

STILLWATER TOWNSHIP, SUSSEX COUNTY, NJ

A rare acidic seep near Arctic Meadows makes this a unique wetland habitat.

Gandy's Beach Preserve

CUMBERLAND COUNTY, NJ

A top shorebird site within the extraordinary migratory crossroads of the Delaware Bay, the preserve's extensive marshes also protect the area from the impacts of storms.

Eldora Nature Preserve

DENNIS AND MAURICE RIVER TOWNSHIPS, NJ

Eldora Nature Preserve is the first preserve established to protect rare moths, butterflies and skippers. Trails traverse meadows, marshes, woodlands and open upland fields.

Indian Trail Swamp Preserve

CAPE MAY PENINSULA, NJ

Situated in the outer coastal plain on the Cape May Peninsula and within the Cape May Forest, Indian Trail Swamp Preserve is home to a lush and diverse habitat.
